


French Polynesia


- French Polynesia consists of 130 islands in five archipelagoes.

- **Tahiti & Bora Bora in leeward Society Islands**








Full provisioning – All meals & snacks for everyday of your charter.


Split provisioning – same as above but with fewer dinners.








Uturoa is the only large town on Raiatea. Three miles from charter base. Three supermarkets and many restuarants.








Motus (small coral islands) abound on the barrier reefs.







Few cemeteries. Mausoleums on family property.








Two very quiet islands attached by a bridge. 20 miles of road. Pop. 5000.




Fare only town on island.




