




Where is French Polynesia?



French Polynesia

- French Polynesia consists of 130 islands in five archipelagos.
- Roughly the size of Europe!
- Tahiti in the leeward Society Islands



Society Islands



Raiatea, Taha'a, Bora Bora and Huahine are the typical cruising grounds.

Tahiti to Uturoa Airport (RFP) on Raiatea is a 35-minute plane ride (130 miles).

- The Society Islands consist of 15 land masses. 10 mountainous islands and 5 coral atolls.
- Named by Captain Cook in 1769.
- Tahiti is the largest island and the capital of French Polynesia

International flights fly into Faa'a Int'l Airport (PPT) in Tahiti's capital city of Papeete.



When To Go?

Prime season (driest, most expensive) July-Sept


Shoulder season (slightly more rain and less expensive) May-June & Oct-Nov





- 130 miles from Tahiti.

Uturoa is the only large town on Raiatea. Three miles from charter base. Three supermarkets and many restaurants.

The Sacred Island


- Very few beaches.
- Eight passes through the barrier reef. Three are closed to charterers.
- Passes clearly marked on charts. Many have range markers.







No sewerage in lagoon.


Few cemeteries. Mausoleums on

The Pearl Of The South Seas


- North & West lagoons deep and sailable.
- One pass through barrier reef.
- East lagoon shallow. Must motor.
- South lagoon impassable.

Lagoonarium – fenced in natural lagoon where you can swim with turtles, sharks, rays and open ocean fish.

Two very quiet islands attached by a bridge. 20 miles of road. Pop. 5000.

Three usable passes through barrier reef (ORANGE). Two closed (YELLOW). Restricted areas (RED).

No moorings or anchoring in Maroe Bay

Look south from Fare to see Pregnant Lady laying down mountain range.

Fees imposed for mooring balls in Bora Bora.

Anchoring locations very limited.

- Boat cost and groceries similar to BVI's
- Services (restaurants and tours) expensive
- Chartering – good selection of charter companies
- Navigation - line of sight, well marked waterways, good charts provided
- Sailing - 2 open water sails (Bora Bora & Huahine). Good sailing in protected lagoons
- Raiatea – Airport/Charter Base/Larger grocery stores/Restaurants
- Taha'a – quiet/vanilla & pearl farms/few restaurants/lovely
- Bora Bora – many resorts but still relatively quiet. Beautiful east lagoon.
- Huahine – very quiet
- Moorea – most activities for tourists. Not in typical charter sailing grounds
